**CHAPTER 33.**

AN ACT to amend 234.26 (10) of the statutes, relating to temporary extension of the effective period of the emergency rent control law.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. In view of the belated action of congress in passing the federal housing and rent act of 1949 and the uncertainty existing in respect to the context and operative effect of the provisions of said act, it is deemed advisable to temporarily retain the present provisions of section 234.26 of the Wisconsin statutes, to meet such emergency and afford adequate opportunity and time to determine upon due deliberation the appropriate action to be taken in light of the provisions of said federal housing and rent act of 1949.

SECTION 2. 234.26 (10) of the statutes is amended to read:  
234.26 (10) This section shall continue in effect until \* \* \* *May 15, 1949.*
