**CHAPTER 591.**

AN ACT to amend 26.14 (3) of the statutes, relating to rates of pay for labor in suppressing forest fires.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

26.14 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

26.14 (3) Emergency fire wardens, and all persons employed by them or by any other duly appointed fire warden for the purpose of suppressing forest fires, shall receive such *hourly* pay as the commission may determine, \* \* \* for the time actually employed. Equipment operators and other specialists shall be paid the prevailing wage rate for comparable skills in each locality \* \* \*. And in addition thereto the commission may allow the cost of meals, transportation and disbursements for emergency equipment. One-half of such expense shall be paid by the state and one-half by the county where such service was performed.
