CHAPTER 217

AN ACT to create 40.34 (1) (h) of the statutes, relating to transportation of elementary school pupils in isolated areas.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.34 (1) (h) of the statutes is created to read:

40.34 (1) (h) When the district board and the parents cannot agree upon the method of transporting elementary school pupils, the transportation shall be provided for by the parents of such pupils who shall receive 20 cents per day for each pupil so transported or such compensation as the state superintendent shall determine if requested, in writing, by the district board and the parents. In lieu of determining the compensation to be paid, the state superintendent may provide for such other means of transportation as he shall consider just.
