CHAPTER 368

AN ACT to create 40.31 (1a) of the statutes, relating to validation of school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.31 (1a) of the statutes is created to read:

40.31 (1a) This section shall be liberally construed to effect the legislative purpose to validate and make certain the legal existence of all school districts in the state of Wisconsin, however created, and to bar every right to question the existence thereof in any manner and to bar every remedy therefor notwithstanding any and all defects and irregularities, jurisdictional or otherwise, after the expiration of such 4-month period except where some action or proceeding has been commenced within such 4-month period.
