**CHAPTER 519**

AN ACT to amend 51.23 of the statutes, relating to commitment of mentally deficient and epileptic persons.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

51.23 of the statutes is amended to read:

51.23 Ss. 51.01 to 51.11, 51.125, 51.14, 51.16, 51.17 \* \* \*, 51.19 and 51.215 shall govern the examination and commitment of mentally deficient and epileptic persons to such colony and training schools, so far as may be applicable. In cases of alleged mental deficiency, one of the examiners under s. 51.01 (2) may be a clinical psychologist who has a doctorate degree in psychology and who has had 3 years of experience in clinical psychology. This amendment (1947) shall be effective as of July 1, 1946.
