#### CHAPTER 152

AN ACT to amend 20.175 (1) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 204, laws of 1955 (Bill No. 73, A.), relating to the purchase of certain land by the state department of public welfare and making an appropriation of \$35,000 therefor.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

20.175 (1) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 204, laws of 1955 (Bill No. 73, A.), is amended to read:

20.175 (1) All balances to the credit of the department of public welfare, state board of health and state superintendent of public instruction at the close of business on June 30, 1941, under s. 20.17 (13), statutes of 1939, and all moneys received by said departments from the sale of livestock and farm products and from premiums on exhibits at fairs, to be used as a revolving appropriation for operation, maintenance, and permanent property and improvements of the respective institutional farms and for incidental expenses connected with exhibits at fairs. Whenever said unincumbered revolving appropriation balance is in excess of \$200,000 on June 30 of any year such excess shall revert to the general fund. *The department of public welfare is hereby authorized and directed to use funds available to the department under this appropriation to exercise the option to purchase approximately 98 acres of land in Walworth*

*county adjacent to the Wisconsin school for the deaf for a price of \$35,000 as provided in an option dated April 30, 1955, between Malcolm Johnson and the state of Wisconsin (state superintendent of public instruction).*
