CHAPTER 261

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 40.14 (2) of the statutes, relating to annexation of territory to union high school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.14 (2) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

40.14 (2) If the high school board approves the petition, the matter shall be submitted by said board to a meeting of the electors of said territory held at the regular place of holding the annual meeting of the high school district, at 8 p.m. on the date set by said board, which shall not be less than 2 nor more than 4 weeks from the date of the approval of the petition by the board. The clerk of said high school district shall give at least 10 days' notice of said meeting, embodying therein the date, time and place of the meeting and the proposal to be submitted, by posting copies thereof in at least 8 public places in said territory. Said meeting shall be conducted by the officers of the high school district in the manner of conducting a meeting of the school district. The vote on the proposal shall be taken by ballot, which ballot shall contain a description of the territory to be annexed by section and portions of sections, and the question on the ballot shall be "Shall the territory herein described be annexed to the _______ school district.

If a majority of the electors voting at said meeting are in favor thereof, said territory shall thereby be annexed.
