CHAPTER 379

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 370.01 (7a) of the statutes, relating to the definition of express highway or expressway.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

370.01 (7a) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

370.01 (7a) EXPRESS HIGHWAY OR EXPRESSWAY. An express highway or expressway is a divided arterial highway for through traffic with "full" or "partial" control of access and generally with grade separations at intersections. "Full" control of access means that the authority to control access is exercised to give preference to through traffic by providing access connections with selected public roads only and by prohibiting crossings at grade or direct private driveway connections. "Partial" control of access means that the authority to control access is exercised to give preference to through traffic to a degree that, in addition to access connections with selected public roads, there may be some crossings at grade and some private driveway connections.
