CHAPTER 344

AN ACT to amend 35.84 (13) of the statutes, relating to free distribution of the inventory of Wisconsin natural resources.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

35.84 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.84 (13) Of the inventory of Wisconsin natural resources: to each constitutional officer, 2 copies; to each member of the current legislature * * *, one copy, provided that each such member may requisition * * * 10 additional free copies; to each member of the supreme court, one copy; to each member and member-elect of the U.S. congress, one copy; to each member of the natural resources committee and its working groups, one copy; to each public library, one copy; to each high school library, one copy * * *; to the libraries of the state university and its extension centers, a total of 50 copies; to each library of the state colleges, 5 copies; to Marquette university library, 20 copies; to each private educational institution of college rank, 5 copies; to the state historical society, 5 copies; to the legislative reference library, 10 copies; and to the free library commission, 10 copies; provided, that further free distribution may be made to the libraries of other educational institutions within the state, to each as provided by this section for libraries of comparable public educational institutions. *To the state superintendent not more than 16,000 copies for free distribution to the public schools and libraries of the state in such numbers, respectively, as he deems best in the interest of conservation education; and to the natural resources committee of state agencies not more than 7,000 copies for free distribution to the other schools of the state, to educational institutions of other states, to agencies of the state and local government, to organized groups including conservation, farm, labor, civic, industrial, commercial and others comparable, whose ready access to the inventory is deemed advantageous to the state.* Such free distribution shall be made following a request * * * by the *state superintendent or the natural resources committee of state agencies or its authorized officer.* * * *
