**CHAPTER 56**

AN ACT to amend 26.14 (6) of the statutes, relating to forest fires and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

26.14 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

26.14 (6) Any person who \* \* \* sets a fire or \* \* \* assists in the setting of a fire, including a back fire, upon his own land or ~~land under his control~~ and who \* \* \* allows such fire to escape and become a forest fire shall \* \* \* be fined not less than \$10 and not to exceed \$100, or imprisoned not exceeding 2 months, or both.
