CHAPTER 81

AN ACT to renumber 151.02 (2) (d); and to amend 151.02 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to pharmacy internship.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 151.02 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

151.02 (2) (a) Graduation from a school or college of pharmacy or a department of pharmacy of a university, which is recognized by the board and which requires for graduation at least a 4-year course. Credit for actual time of attendance at the school, college or department of pharmacy of a university shall be given on the required 48 months of pharmaceutical training; the remainder of the 48 months must be practice and experience in a retail pharmacy or drug store under the direction and supervision of a registered pharmacist, which practice and experience shall be predominantly work directly related to the selling of drugs, preparing and compounding of pharmaceutical preparations and physicians' prescriptions, and keeping of records and making of reports required under state and federal statutes. The said practice and experience shall include an aggregate of 12 calendar months commencing not earlier than the close of the sophomore college year. Credit for such periods of practice and experience shall be allowed in the discretion of the board in accordance with such regulations as it may from time to time adopt. There shall be a fee of \$1 for registration of apprentices under this subsection. *The board may upon satisfactory proof recognize and accept evidence of said practice and experience performed in whole or in part in any other state provided*

the same is approved and verified by the state board of pharmacy or equivalent agency of such other state.

SECTION 2. 151.02 (2) (d) of the statutes is renumbered 151.02 (2) (b).
