**CHAPTER 525**

AN ACT to amend 142.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to transportation for physically handicapped children.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

142.05 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

142.05 (3) In the case of \* \* \* *physically handicapped* children to be admitted *and transported* to the Wisconsin orthopedic hospital for children or any other hospital the county judge may apply for aid to the bureau for handicapped children, state department of public instruction, for cost of transportation not to exceed railroad or bus fare and necessary taxi *or ambulance* service for such patients, and any necessary attendant, if the parents or guardians are financially unable to pay such costs. If approval is granted by the bureau for handicapped children, state department of public instruction, reimbursement will be made to the county for funds so expended.
