CHAPTER 210

AN ACT to amend 35.08 (1) of the statutes, relating to the number of copies of rejected amendments to be printed.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

35.08 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.08 (1) There shall be printed 500, or 1,000 copies of each bill or joint resolution and amendments thereto, the quantity to be determined by the chief clerk of the house in which the bill, or resolution, or amendment originates. The format shall correspond to that of the 1959 session. The chief clerk may print a lesser number of floor amendments which were rejected upon introduction.
