CHAPTER 24

AN ACT to amend 129.17 of the statutes, relating to peddling finger alphabet cards, and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

129.17 of the statutes is amended to read:

129.17 No person shall in this state engage in the business of peddling finger alphabet cards or printed matter stating that the person is deaf, or use finger alphabet cards or such printed matter or masquerade as a deaf person in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise; and no state or local license as provided in this chapter shall be issued to any person for the purpose of peddling finger alphabet cards or printed matter stating that the person is deaf or masquerading as a deaf person. Any person who * * * peddles finger alphabet cards or such printed matter or * * uses the same, or masquerades as a deaf person in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise in this state and any person who * * * issues any state or local license as provided in this chapter for that purpose * * * may be imprisoned not more than * * * 90 days or * * * fined not less than * * \$25 nor more than * * \$100 or both.
