**CHAPTER 318**

AN ACT to amend 29.147 (3) and (4) of the statutes, relating to sportsmen's licenses.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

29.147 (3) and (4) of the statutes are amended to read:

29.147 (3) Each license shall state the year for which the same is issued, the name and residence of the licensee, a description of his person, and such other matter as \* \* \* is determined by the commission, and shall bear upon its face a true signature of the licensee, and the seal of the conservation commission or the signature of its duly authorized agent issuing it. Such license shall be carried on the person of the licensee at all times when he is engaged in hunting, trapping or fishing and shall be exhibited to the state conservation commission or its deputies on demand. Such license shall be in lieu of, and confer upon the licensee all the combined rights and privileges conferred by, a resident *small game* hunting \* \* \* license, resident fishing license, \* \* \* resident deer hunting license and trapping license, subject, however to all the duties, conditions, limitations and restrictions prescribed in this chapter, and by conservation commission order.

(4) The conservation commission or its duly authorized agents issuing any such license shall furnish to the applicant a deer tag \* \* \* during years of open season for such animals.
