CHAPTER 511

AN ACT authorizing the board of regents of the state colleges to sell state-owned lands therein described, located in the city of Eau Claire, to the Sacred Heart hospital, and crediting the proceeds to the appropriation made by section 20.760 of the statutes, and authorizing said department to expend therefrom amounts for paying the expenses of the sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The secretary of the board of regents of state colleges, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey that portion of

the state-owned lands which are now a part of the premises of the Wisconsin state colleges described as follows:

“That part of Government Lot 1 of Section 30, Township 27 North of Range 9 West, City of Eau Claire, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, being further described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of said Gov. Lot 1; thence N 0° 15' E along the east line of said Gov. Lot 1, a distance of 772.75 feet to a point on the southerly limits of the lands now owned by the said board of regents; thence S 49° 53' 30'' W along the southerly limits of said lands owned by the said board of regents, a distance of 940.0 feet; thence S 29° 39' 30'' W along said southerly limits of land owned by the said board of regents, a distance of 195.0 feet to a point on the south line of said Gov. Lot 1; thence N 89° 50' 30'' E along the said south line of said Gov. Lot 1, a distance of 812.0 feet to the point of beginning of this description”;

at such price and under such terms, conditions and covenants as the secretary determines; and the proceeds of such sales shall be deposited in the general fund and credited to the appropriation made by section 20.760 of the statutes and the board of regents of state colleges is authorized to pay the expenses of such sales out of said appropriation.
