CHAPTER 520

AN ACT to amend 23.09 (7) (intro. par.) of the statutes, relating to long-range plans of the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

23.09 (7) (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:

23.09 (7) (intro. par.) COMMISSION RULES; STUDIES; SURVEYS; SERVICES; PENALTIES; POWERS; LONG-RANGE PLANNING. The commission * * *

*may make such rules * * * , inaugurate such studies, investigations and surveys, and establish such services as * * * it deems necessary to carry out the provisions and purposes of this act, and any violation of any provisions of this act, or of any rules * * * promulgated by the commission, shall constitute a misdemeanor and be punished as hereinafter provided. The commission shall establish long-range plans, projects and priorities for conservation which shall thereafter be carried out by the director. Such plans, projects and priorities shall be reviewed and projected by the commission every 2 years and a report thereon rendered to the governor by September 1 of each odd-numbered year. The commission shall also have authority :*
