CHAPTER 596

AN ACT to amend chapter 518, laws of 1947, section 3 (approximate mileage) (TOTAL) and section 5, as last amended by chapter 619, laws of 1957; and to create chapter 518, laws of 1947, section 3 (new paragraph), relating to additions to the state trunk highway system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 518, laws of 1947, section 3 (new paragraph) is created to read:

(Chapter 518, laws of 1947) Section 3 (new paragraph).
From STH 27 at Wilson Corners in Rusk county in an easterly direction generally along CTH "D" to the Rusk county line; and thence easterly through Taylor county along said highway to STH 73 in Taylor county, a distance of approximately 17 miles.

SECTION 2. Chapter 518, laws of 1947, section 3 (approximate mileage) (TOTAL) and section 5, as amended by chapter 619, laws of 1957, are amended to read:

(Chapter 518, laws of 1947) Section 3 (approximate mileage).
TOTAL * * * 947.17

(Chapter 518, laws of 1947) Section 5. In addition to the mileage specified in section 3, the state highway commission is authorized to add to the state trunk highway system additional mileage to a total of not to exceed 145 miles, making a total addition of not to exceed * * * 1,081 miles.

Explanatory Note: Chapters 596, 597 and 598, Laws of 1961, each add mileage to the State Trunk Highway System and change totals of the mileages specified in Chapter 518, Laws of 1947, as amended by Chapter 619, Laws of 1957, without correlation with each other. The cumulative effect of Chapters 596, 597 and 598, Laws of 1961, together makes a total of approximately 971.65 miles for Section 3 and a total of approximately 1,105.48 miles for Section 5, Chapter 518, Laws of 1947.
