**CHAPTER 601**

AN ACT to amend 151.07 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to the definition of a dangerous drug.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

151.07 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

151.07 (1) (a) "Dangerous drug" means any drug or drug-containing preparation, *the original container of which bears the statement "Caution—federal law prohibits dispensing without prescription" and includes, without limitation because of enumeration, any preparation intended for*

*internal administration which contains barbiturates, sulfonamides, thyroid, cinchophen, neocinchopen, aminopyrine, amphetamine, desoxyephedrine, diethyl-stilbestrol, ergot or any salts, derivatives, compounds or mixtures thereof.* No compound, mixture or preparation is deemed a dangerous drug if it is designed for the purpose of treating animals or poultry and is so labeled.
