CHAPTER 617

AN ACT to create chapter 495, laws of 1961, section 162m, relating to providing that civil action judgments, entered in courts abolished under the court reorganization acts, be judgments of the civil division of the county court.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 495, laws of 1961, section 162m, is created to read:

(Chapter 495, laws of 1961) Section 162m. All judgments of the civil court of Milwaukee county or of any other court functioning under chapter 254 of the statutes or of any other court which ceases to function on the first Monday in January, 1962, and which were entered prior to said date shall, as of said date, become judgments of the county court, civil division, in the county where said judgment was entered for all purposes but no such judgment shall have any other effect than when originally entered.
