CHAPTER 68

AN ACT to amend 69.29 (1) of the statutes, relating to revising the standard birth certificate in order to conform to existing statutes as to the burden of proof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

69.29 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

69.29 (1) The certificate of birth shall contain such items as the state board of health * * * *determines* are necessary and shall agree in the main with the standard form recommended by the U. S. public health service * * *. Whenever a child is born to a woman while she is the lawful wife of a specified man, the certificate of birth for such child shall list the name of the husband as the father of such child unless and until the * * * *paternity* of such child is proven * * * *by clear and satisfactory preponderance of the evidence* and in any proceeding under ss. 52.21 to 52.45 such birth record shall not be admissible in evidence.
