CHAPTER 96

AN ACT to amend 69.05 and 69.06 (1) of the statutes, relating to use of certain marriage forms supplied by state registrar.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

69.05 and 69.06 (1) of the statutes are amended to read:

69.05 The state registrar shall prepare forms of certificate of birth, fetal deaths, deaths, marriages, divorces and of burial permits, and such other forms necessary to meet the requirements of this chapter, which forms, *with the exception of marriage license forms*, shall be printed and

supplied in the same manner as are blanks and stationery for the use of other offices of the state government.

69.06 (1) The state registrar shall prepare and issue detailed instructions required to secure the uniform observance and the maintenance of a perfect system of registration, and no blanks, *with the exception of marriage license blanks*, shall be used other than those supplied by him.
