CHAPTER 541

AN ACT to amend 319.04 (2) (intro. par.); and to create 231.60 and 319.04 (2) (d) of the statutes, relating to small trusts or estates benefitting incompetents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 231.60 of the statutes is created to read:

231.60 SMALL TRUSTS BENEFITING INCOMPETENTS. If an incompetent, as defined in s. 319.01, is entitled to the benefit of a trust of a value of \$1,500 or less, any court wherein an action or proceeding involving said trust is pending may, in its discretion, without requiring the appointment of a guardian, order the payment of such benefit to the person having actual or legal custody of the incompetent or to the person providing for his care and maintenance for the benefit of the incompetent.

Section 2. 319.04 (2) (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:

319.04 (2) (intro. par.) If a minor or an incompetent, except for his incapacity, is entitled to possession of personal property of a value of

\$1,500 or less, any court wherein * * * an action or proceeding involving said property is pending may, in its discretion, without requiring the appointment of a guardian, order one of the following:

SECTION 3. 319.04 (2) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

319.04 (2) (d) Payment to the person having actual or legal custody of the incompetent or to the person providing for his care and maintenance for the benefit of the incompetent.
