CHAPTER 184

AN ACT to create 95.39 (3) of the statutes, relating to the sale and distribution of biological products for the treatment, diagnosis or prevention of animal diseases and granting rule-making authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

95.39 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

95.39 (3) Biological products produced or packed outside this state for the treatment, diagnosis or prevention of animal diseases and licensed by the federal government under experimental or special licenses may be sold, distributed or used only under such conditions as the department prescribes. The department may make such rules governing the conditions of manufacture, sale, distribution or use of biological products for the treatment, diagnosis or prevention of animal diseases as are necessary for the protection of animal health, including permit requirements or other restrictions on the importation, sale or experimental use of such products.
