CHAPTER 416

AN ACT to amend 194.04 (1) (b) and (c) of the statutes, relating to licenses and permits granted by the public service commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

194.04 (1) (b) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

194.04 (1) (b) Every application for a certificate shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$40. Every application for approval of an assignment or lease of a certificate or for an amendment to a certificate *except an amendment to a certificate under the federal motor carrier act of 1935* shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$40. No fee shall be required for an application for abandonment of service under all or any part of a certificated authority nor for a restatement of authority contained in a certificate without enlarging the same.

(c) Every application for a license or for approval of assignment or lease thereof or for an amendment thereto *except an amendment to a license under the federal motor carrier act of 1935* shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$25. Only one fee shall be required when an application for assignment and application for amendment are filed simultaneously by one applicant.
