AN ACT to amend 101.31 (7) (f) of the statutes, relating to the use of the word "engineering" in the name of a firm, partnership or cor-

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

101.31 (7) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:
101.31 (7) (f) Any firm, partnership or corporation using the word "engineering" or any of its derivatives in its firm, partnership or corporation name prior to April 24, 1964, shall be permitted to continue to do so and shall be permitted to use such word in any new firm, partnership or corporation formed as a result of a reorganization of such firm, partnership or corporation, provided such firm, partnership or corporation it does not practice or offer to practice architecture or professional engineering unless they comply with all other provisions of this section.
