**CHAPTER 188, LAWS OF 1967**

AN ACT to amend 267.13 (4) of the statutes, relating to release of garnishee.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

267.13 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

267.13 (4) If no such request is made and the garnishee does not elect to pay such sum to the clerk, the garnishee shall hold the same until order of the court. ~~No stipulation between the plaintiff and the defendant shall be honored by the garnishee, until signed and approved by the court.~~ *Any stipulation between the plaintiff and defendant shall be filed with the court.*
