## CHAPTER 50, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to repeal 41.72 (4); and to amend 16.08 (2) (d) of the statutes, relating to placing teachers at the Wisconsin school for the deaf under the classified service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 16.08 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

16.08 (2) (d) All presidents, deans, principals, professors, instructors, research assistants, librarians and other teachers, as defined in s. 42.20, in the university, and state colleges and the Wisconsin school for the deaf.

SECTION 2. 41.72 (4) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. No person affected by this act shall suffer the loss of any accrued fringe benefits derived from his employment, such as accumulated sick leave or earned vacation time, because of this act, nor shall any person's monthly salary be reduced because of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1967. Approved June 26, 1967.
