CHAPTER 315, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 118.12 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to school board members interests in school district purchases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

118.12 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

118.12 (1) (a) Within the school district of his jurisdiction or employment, no school teacher, agency coordinator, school district administrator, school board member or other school employe connected with any public school may act as an agent or solicitor for the sale of school books, school supplies or school equipment, or solicit or promote such sales to individuals or the school district or receive any fee or reward for any such sales.
