CHAPTER 367, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 13.26 (1) (b) of the statutes, relating to disorderly conduct before a committee of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.26 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.26 (1) (b) Disorderly conduct in the immediate view of the either house or of any committee thereof and directly tending to interrupt its proceedings.
