CHAPTER 431, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 125.16 of the statutes, relating to identification of watches.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.16 of the statutes is created to read:

125.16 WATCHMAKERS NUMBERS. (1) The watchmaking examining board shall assign each watchmaker an identification number. A list of identification numbers shall be maintained by the department and shall be made available to any law enforcement agency requesting such information.

(2) Each watchmaker shall inscribe his identification number in each watchcase he repairs unless the repair is crystal replacement. Each watchmaker shall maintain a record which includes the name and address of customer or owner and date of repair work. Failure to maintain such a record shall be considered just cause for revocation or suspension of a watchmaker's registration certificate.

SECTION 2. CONFLICTS. If this act and chapter , (1969 Senate Bill 353), laws of 1969, are both enacted then section 125.16 of the statutes, as created by this act is renumbered section 454.16.
