**CHAPTER 91, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to amend 120.48 (1) of the statutes, relating to meetings of city school boards.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

120.48 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

120.48 (1) The school board in a city school district shall hold regular monthly meetings at such times as it prescribes by rule. Special meetings may be held under rules adopted by the school board. *The school board shall inform the public of its regular monthly meetings, either by publication of a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, with the specific exception that insertion thereof need not be at least one week before the meeting, or by other means which may include posting.* All school board meetings shall be open to the public, except as follows: ~~(a) If the school board resolves itself~~

into a committee of the whole, the committee may exclude the public from the committee meeting. (b) *provided in s. 14.90 and except that the public shall be excluded from a hearing before the school board on charges against whom the charges are preferred.*
