CHAPTER 436, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to appropriate \$25,362.73 from the conservation fund for payment of a claim made by Juneau county against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against state. There is appropriated from the conservation fund \$25,362.73 to Juneau county to compensate it for expenses incurred in fighting a forest fire which started on August 28, 1976, at Camp Douglas, Wisconsin. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim by the county arising as a result of such fire fighting activities.
