CHAPTER 31, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 971.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to a plea of guilty for crimes committed in several counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 971.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

971.09 (1) Any person who admits that he or she has committed ~~felonies or violations of s. 943.24, or both,~~ crimes in the county in which he or she is in custody and also in another county in this state, may apply to the district attorney of the county in which he or she is in custody to be charged with those crimes so that ~~he~~ the person may plead guilty and be sentenced for them in the county of custody. The application shall contain a

description of all admitted crimes and the name of the county in which each was committed.
