1991 WISCONSIN ACT 157

AN ACT to repeal 115.45 (4) (b) 2; to consolidate, renumber and amend 115.45 (4) (b) (intro.) and 1; and to create 115.45 (4) (h) and 115.45 (6) (c) of the statutes, relating to: the requirements for preschool to grade 5 programs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 115.45 (4) (b) (intro.) and 1 of the statutes are consolidated, renumbered 115.45 (4) (b) and amended to read:

115.45 (4) (b) Beginning in the 1987–88 school year, each Each identified school or private service provider shall: 1. Annually annually test the pupils enrolled in preschool programs and in grades 1 to 35 in reading, language arts and mathematics using tests approved by the department.

SECTION 2. 115.45 (4) (b) 2. of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 115.45 (4) (h) of the statutes is created to read:

115.45 (4) (h) Annually, each identified school or private service provider shall report to the state superintendent all of the following:

1. The results of the tests under par. (b).

2. The number and content of in-service training activities under par. (f).

3. The number and content of parental involvement activities and the number of parents attending each activity.

SECTION 4. 115.45 (6) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

115.45 (6) (c) Annually submit to the legislature under s. 13.172 (2) a report on the academic progress made by pupils enrolled in preschool to grade 5 programs under this section.
