# 1991 WISCONSIN ACT 252

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$245,643.89 from the general fund for payment of claims against the state made by 36 claimants in connection with the bankruptcy of Kasson, Inc., USA.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1. Claims against the state.** There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (d) of the statutes \$245,643.89 in payment of the following claims against the state, made by the following claimants, to compensate them for the value of milk shipped to Kasson, Inc., USA of Brillion, Wisconsin, in 1989, for which they have not been timely

paid as a result of bankruptcy proceedings. The claimants contend that the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection failed to monitor the financial condition of Kasson, Inc., USA and to enforce section 100.06, 1987 stats., relating to financial security requirements for dairy plants. Acceptance of these payments releases this state, its officers, employes and agents from any further liability resulting from these losses. Payments shall be made to the following claimants in the amounts shown:
