1993 WISCONSIN ACT 173

AN ACT *to amend* 12.03 (2) of the statutes, **relating to:** electioneering near polling places on election day.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 12.03 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

12.03 (2) No person may engage in electioneering during polling hours on any public property on election day within ~~500~~ 100 feet of an entrance to a building containing a polling place. This subsection does not apply to the placement of any material on the bumper of a motor vehicle that is located on such property on election day.
