1993 WISCONSIN ACT 442

AN ACT to create 84.1038 and 227.01 (13) (yg) of the statutes, **relating to:** designating and marking a certain highway route as the “Iron Brigade Memorial Highway” and providing an exemption from rule-making procedures.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 84.1038 of the statutes is created to read:

84.1038 Iron Brigade memorial highway. The department shall designate and mark, consistent with any standards that may be developed by the department for memorial highway designations, USH 12 from the state line in Walworth county to the state line in St. Croix

county as the “Iron Brigade Memorial Highway” as a living memorial to and in honor of the members of the Second, Sixth and Seventh Wisconsin regiments who served in the Iron Brigade of the Union army in the Civil War of 1861 to 1865.

SECTION 1g. 227.01 (13) (yg) of the statutes is created to read:

227.01 **(13)** (yg) Relates to standards for memorial highway designations authorized under s. 84.1038.
