## 1993 Wisconsin Act 76 (Vetoed in Part)

AN ACT to create 20.435 (6) (ed) of the statutes, relating to administration of the state supplement to the federal supplemental security income program and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 20.435 (6) (ed) of the statutes is created to read:

20.435 (6) (ed) *Administrative expenses for state supplement to federal supplemental security income program.* A sum sufficient to pay for administrative fees charged by the federal government for federal administration of state supplemental grants to supplemental security income recipients under s. 49.177.

SECTION 2. **Nonstatutory provisions; study.** The department of health and social services shall prepare a study of the feasibility of having the state assume responsibility for the administration of the state supplement grant program under section 49.177 of the

statutes. This study shall evaluate the costs and benefits of administering the program directly or by contracting with an outside vendor. The results of the study shall be submitted to the joint committee on finance no later than March 1, 1994. If the results of the study indicate that it would be cost-effective for the state to assume responsibility for the administration of the state supplement grant program under section 49.177 of the statutes, the department of health and social services shall submit, with the results of the study, proposed legislation for the state to assume responsibility for administration of the state supplement grant program under section 49.177 of the statutes.
