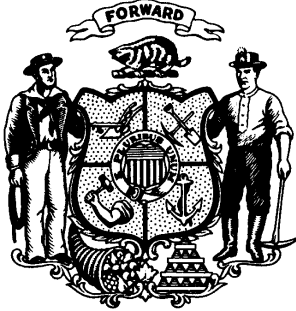

1995 WISCONSIN ACT 137

AN ACT to create 144.42 (5) (i) of the statutes; relating to: exempting farm trucks from the motor vehicle emission inspection and maintenance program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 144.42 (5) (i) of the statutes is created to read:

144.42 (5) (i) A farm truck as defined in s. 340.01 (18) (a). This paragraph does not apply after June 30, 1996.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 1993-94: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
