1997 WISCONSIN ACT 40

AN ACT relating to: ratification of an amendment to the agreement negotiated between the state of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association, Inc., for the 1997–99 biennium, covering employes in the professional legal collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of funds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Agreement ratified. Notwithstanding sections 111.91 (2) (d) and 111.92 (2) of the statutes, the legislature ratifies the amendment to the ratified agreement for the 1997–99 biennium between the state of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association, Inc., covering employes in the professional legal collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, which amendment was approved by the employes of the professional legal collective bargaining unit and, on October 28, 1997, was approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations. The legislature authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations

made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The secretary of employment relations shall file an official copy of the amendment to the agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties which is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

(1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the amendment to the agreement covering employes in the professional legal collective bargaining unit are effective on the dates provided in the amendment.

"Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
