## 1999 WISCONSIN ACT 138

AN ACT *to repeal* 218.01 (3a); and *to amend* 218.01 (8) of the statutes; **relating to:** misuse of a distinctive dealer registration plate by a motor vehicle dealer, distributor, transporter or manufacturer.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** 218.01 (3a) of the statutes is repealed.

**SECTION 2.** 218.01 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

218.01 (8) PENALTIES. Except for sub. (3) (a) 1., 3., 6., 7., 11., 12., 13., 20., 25., 29. and 30., and except for violations for sub. (2) (a), (2a), ~~(3a)-(e)~~ or (7b), any person violating this section may be required to forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$500 for each violation.

\* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 1997-98: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
