



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative of the Wisconsin Assembly from the Wisconsin Assembly District Milwaukee 1st caused by the assumption of the office of State Senator, Wisconsin Sixth Senatorial District by Mark G. Lipscomb, Jr., on the 4th day of May, A.D., 1971, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, A.D., 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Wisconsin Assembly District Milwaukee 1st on the fourteenth day of September, A.D., 1971, to fill said vacancy, that the Special Primary be held on the seventeenth day of August, A.D., 1971, and that said Special Election and Special Primary shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
