EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43

WHEREAS, Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provides that under the general powers of the Executive Office, the Governor may create and abolish non-statutory committees; and


WHEREAS, said Section provides that any non-statutory committee shall expire on the fourth Monday of January in the year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins, unless the new Governor, by Executive Order, provides for its continued existence; and

WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 19, issued June 29, 1979, pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provided for the continued existence of the Governor's Committee on Minority Business, said entity to remain in effect until January 31, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the provisions of the statutes governing, do hereby provide for the further continuation of the Governor's Committee on Minority Business, to remain in effect until June 30, 1981.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this 23rd day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and eighty.
