EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the Municipal Judge for the Village of Paddock Lake, in the county of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the resignation on April 28, 1981, of Bruce R. Andersen whose term of office would have expired on April 30, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on July 23, 1981. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on May 11, 1981, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., May 28, 1981. The special primary shall be held on June 25, 1981.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the holding of a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Section 8.05(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes on or before May 24, 1981, and the Special Election shall be held on July 23, 1981.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with the law.
