### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 117

WHEREAS, State Senator Donald Hanaway has been elected to the position of Attorney General and has resigned from the Senate effective January 5, 1987, creating a vacancy on that date,

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §8.50(4) order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held in the Second Senate District as described in Stats. §4.009(2), on April 7, 1987, coinciding with the spring election and that if a primary is necessary it be held on February 17, 1987, coinciding with the spring primary. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., January 6, 1987. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
