EXECUTIVE ORDER #8

WHEREAS, I, as Governor, established the Vocational Technical and Adult Education (VTAE) Study Commission by Executive Order #5 on February 25, 1987; and

WHEREAS, it is proper and appropriate to expand its membership and to include representation of the legislative branch of government;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, do hereby enlarge and set the membership of the VTAE Study Commission as follows:

- (a) the Commission shall consist of 14 members;
- (b) four of the members shall be legislators.


All other provisions of Executive Order #5 shall remain in effect.
