EXECUTIVE ORDER #102

Relating to a Special Election for the
Twelfth State Senate District


WHEREAS, State Senator Lloyd Kincaid submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the Twelfth Senate District, effective July 12, 1990,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50 order that a special election be held on November 6, 1990 to fill the vacancy in the Twelfth Senate District as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.009 (12) for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1993, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on September 11, 1990. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., August 7, 1990. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
