



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 350

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Honorable Lewis F. Powell, Jr., Late Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court

WHEREAS, the Honorable Lewis F. Powell, Jr., retired Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court, died at his home in Richmond, Virginia at the age of ninety on Tuesday, August 25, 1998; and


WHEREAS, Justice Powell faithfully and honorably served the people of the United States of America; and

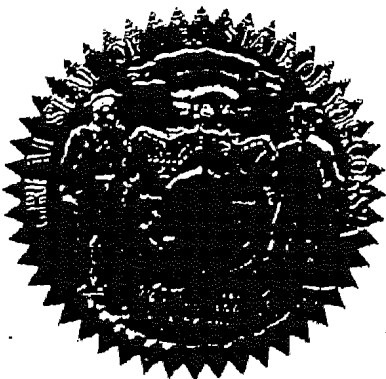
WHEREAS, President Clinton has ordered that the flag of the United States shall be flown at half-staff on the day of Justice Powell's interment; and

WHEREAS, Justice Powell will be interred on Monday, August 31, 1998;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 31, 1998 and ending at sunset on that date.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this thirtieth day of August in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight.
