EXECUTIVE ORDER #166

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Lieutenant Michael Miller of the Green Bay Metro Fire Department

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 20, 2015, Lt. Michael Miller, a firefighter with the Green Bay Metro Fire Department in Green Bay, Wisconsin, died unexpectedly while on duty at the age of forty-five; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Michael Miller served as a firefighter and a paramedic with the Green Bay Metro Fire Department for eighteen years, and he had responded to his last alarm call only hours before his death; and


WHEREAS, Lt. Michael Miller leaves behind a legacy of service as a member of the community in Green Bay, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Lt. Michael Miller in Green Bay, Wisconsin, on Monday, June 29, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Monday, June 29, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
